- 4. Sony Griffen made a motion to start mowing our own grass and buy 1 zero turn, 1 walk behind, and 2 weedeaters. We decided to try and get more bids for the cost of the equipment.
- 5. Quote for the top soil to fix drainage issues was \$600 a load. 8 10 loads will be needed. Karla Reed made a motion to get the top soil. Joan Creasman seconded and it passed unanimously.

New Business

1. Sonya made a motion to let Travis Smith pressure washing get the water spots off the vehicle windows for \$25 a piece. Ken Bailey seconded and it passed unanimously.
